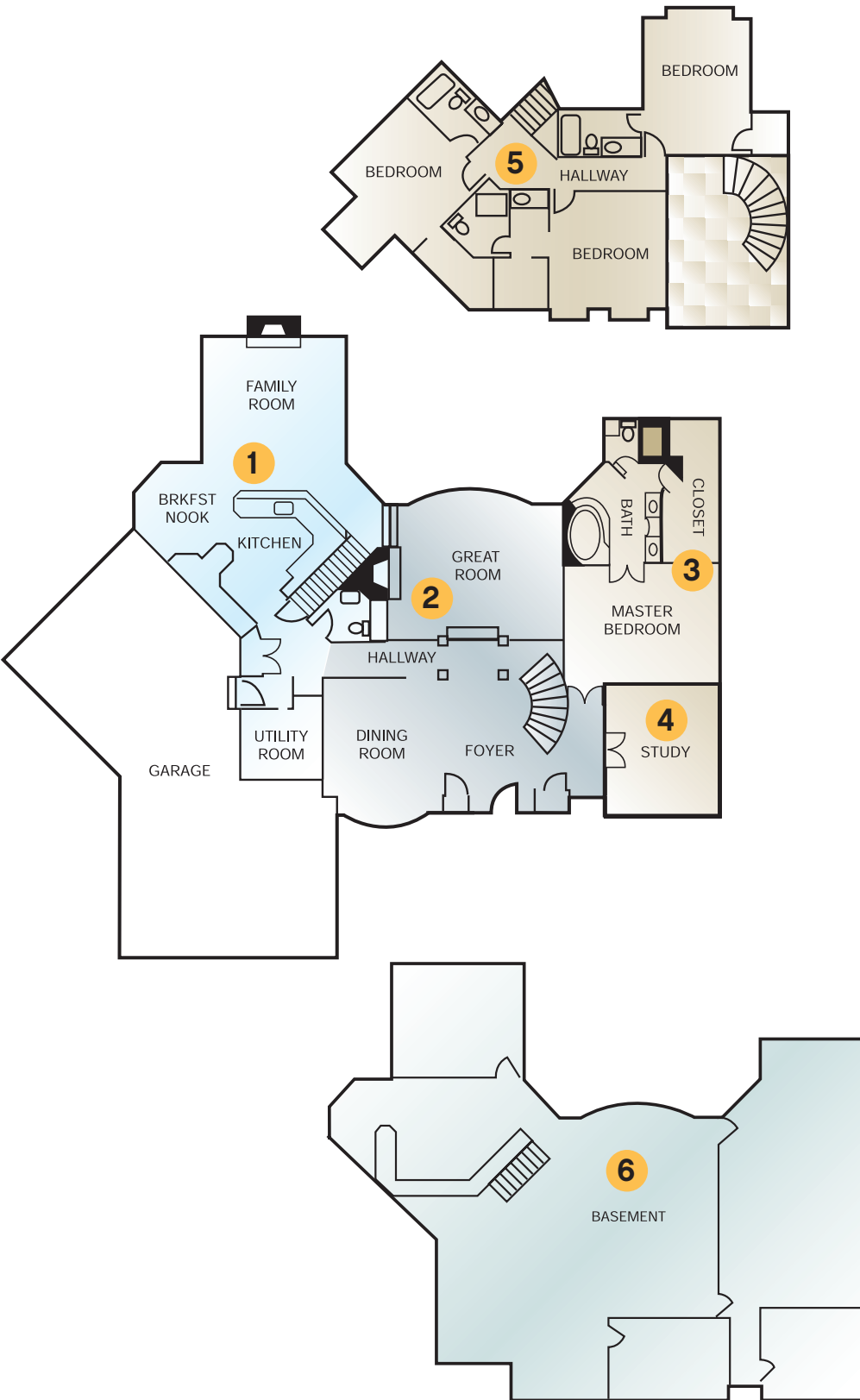
Customize

Customize your indoor comfort with flexible temperature programming in different parts of the house. Your Carrier dealer will work with you to help you decide how to best zone your home for optimum comfort and efficiency. Zoning considerations are based on household use, where the rooms are located along with their relation to each other as well as how much sunlight the rooms typically receive during the day. As an example, use the floor plan pictured to the right.



Technology

- 1 Zone 1:** The kitchen, breakfast nook, family room and utility room are combined into one zone due to similar solar load requirements.
- 2 Zone 2:** The large great room, dining room and foyer are grouped together due to the zone proximity and supply airflow.
- 3 Zone 3:** The master bedroom, master bath and walk-in closet can be programmed as one unit for ideal comfort even at night.
- 4 Zone 4:** Extra bedroom on the main floor isn't used often is ideal for an extra zone. This zone can be set back further and save energy when the room is not in use.
- 5 Zone 5:** Controlling the upstairs as a single zone allows greater comfort for the entire upstairs area.
- 6 Zone 6:** The basement becomes its own zone for more control in all seasons.
